




STUDENT INDUSTRY EXPO October 25, 2023

The Ranch Events Complex Loveland, CO

Last year, NOCO CSP held its' first-ever Construction Con event at the Ranch Events Complex in Loveland, Colo. This hands-on, immersive construction experience provided over 500 high school students from different school districts in Northern Colorado the opportunity to explore the multitude of career opportunities and different pathways into the industry. Over 220 industry and education representatives from different sectors, companies, universities, associations, and apprenticeship programs participated by providing either an activity booth, a job booth, or volunteering to encourage these students to consider a career in construction.
